



**Public Input Meeting to be Held to on the East Grand Forks 2045 Land Use Plan** – The Grand Forks-East Grand Forks Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will hold a public open house meeting on June 18, 2015. Input from community members is needed to help guide the future vision of the city.

The City of East Grand Forks is updating its land use plan to help guide the community towards its vision for the future. The plan will help the community envision growth and redevelopment, improve quality of life, and make the best use of land within the flood protected area.

A public open house is being held early in the planning process to gain citizen input on needs and opportunities that should be addressed in the 30 year planning horizon. The meeting will be an open house format with no formal presentation given.
